Local CANs are helping these kitchens uphold hygiene standards by adhering to strict hand washing, wearing masks, and keeping a safe 1.5m distance from one another.  In some instances, like in Bonteheuwel, the local CAN is linked to the Bonteheuwel Joint Peace Forum who qualify for permits already. In others, there is good coordination with local CBOs or NGOs.
